**Patriots Park** is where our memorial service will be held. It contains the Missouri Vietnam Veterans Memorial which honors the 1,410 servicemen and women from Missouri who gave their lives during the Vietnam War. Built and designed by students, this memorial serves as Missouri's official

Vietnam memorial and is a beautiful accompaniment to a visit to the Veterans Museum in Branson.

The black granite walls of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial are divided – reflecting the division of America. The statue in the middle represents the servicemen and women who stood in the gap and gave what their nation asked of them. The red, flower-filled 'V' stands for valor and represents the blood that was shed during the war.

#### **Showboat Branson Belle**

For over 20 years, the Showboat Branson Belle has cruised the tranquil waters of Table Rock Lake. The 700-passenger paddlewheel riverboat, built to recreate the magic of showboats that entertained crowds in the 1800s, offers two-hour



lunch and dinner cruises, holiday events, kids' cruises and more. At the Showboat Branson Belle's main performance, guests dine facing a large stage onboard, where performers entertain for all ages with singing, dancing and live music featuring hits from the 1960s to today's charts. Enjoy opening acts while being served a hearty meal of slow-simmered beef roast, Caribbean chicken, garlic mashed potatoes, green beans and salad. Don't forget to save room for dessert - Silver Dollar City's lemon-berry ice cream pie is a delightful treat for your taste buds!

A short break after performances gives guests the opportunity to mingle with entertainers and explore the ship's lounges, promenades and decks to admire panoramic views of the surrounding landscape. At White River Landing, the Showboat's dock, you can shop for souvenirs, apparel, jewelry and more at two specialty shops.



### **Presley's Country Jubilee**

Back in 1967 the Presleys built the first LIVE music theatre in Branson, Missouri. Today, Presleys' Theatre is a Branson Landmark, and the Presley family is still here entertaining audiences

After completing a Fleet in-depth overhaul in 1972, Hollister again departed Homeport, this time for her eighteenth deployment to the Western Pacific, carrying a new missile configuration. On 10 August 1972, Hollister became the first U.S. Naval Vessel to ever fire a Surface-to-Surface missile in anger. The missile silenced a North Vietnam Radar site. Only a day before, while on a three ship daylight raid on the Quang Yien storage complex, Hollister received at least 250 rounds of hostile fire. The Task unit destroyed a huge ammunition cache with Hollister returning 193 rounds of fire against enemy shore batteries on the heavily fortified island of Hon Me. This was considered the most daring Destroyer operations of the Vietnam War. The target was destroyed and the Task Unit retired without damage or a single casualty.
