An Historical Note:

Morris Agnew writes the following: My name is Morris Agnew. I served on the Hollister from 1948 to 1950 as fireman first class. I am writing because the history about the Hollister that I have read has never recorded the explosion that took the lives of shipmates on April 20, 1949. They are:

Max Marcellini Archibeque: GM first class

James Rufus Willams: GM first class Paul Hilding Pehn: QM third class

Cecil William: Seaman

Max Marcellini Archibeque was a hero 7 years before his death on the Hollister and was awarded a presidential citation.

For extraordinary heroism, while serving on board the U.S.S. SAN FRAN-CISCO, in the action against Japanese naval forces in the Solomon Islands area on November 12 and 13, 1942. After an enemy plane had crashed into the after machine gun platform and started a large fire, ARCHIBEQUE, with utter disregard for his own personal safety, ably assisted in leading a hose to the top of turret III, and although this turret was firing, he effectively fought the fire while facing the terrific blast. During the night action while under heavy and accurate enemy fire he gallantly assisted in leading a hose into the starboard hangar door in the face of terrific blast from turret III then firing to starboard. Largely as result of his heroic action the fire inside the hangar was extinguished with minimum damage. His performance of duty was in keeping with the highest traditions of the naval service.


Branson Belle:
